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### **Prohibited Weapons Animal Management Permit**

This fact sheet provides information on the requirements for obtaining a Prohibited Weapons Permit for Animal Management - clause 26 of the Weapons Prohibition Regulation 2017.

This permit only authorises a blow gun or blow pipe for animal management purposes.

#### What does the Animal Management Permit authorise?

This permit authorises a person to possess and use a blow gun or blow pipe and a dart for a blow gun or blow pipe for managing an animal in their care. These items are prohibited weapons under Schedule 1 clause 2(8) & (9) of the Weapons Prohibition Act 1998 and possession of these items must be authorised by a permit unless an exemption applies.

In addition to the permit holder, this permit also authorises a person listed on the permit to possess and use a blow gun or blow pipe for managing an animal in the care of the permit holder.

#### Who can apply for this permit?

- A veterinary practitioner, or
- A student enrolled in a veterinary science course, or
- A person applying on behalf of an organisation which is primarily responsible for the management of animals.

#### What is the term of the permit?

The permit will be issued for a maximum term of 5 years.

#### How much will the permit cost?

The prescribed fee for this permit is \$127. Your payment must accompany the application. Please provide credit card details on the reverse of the application form.

An additional \$25 fee is required for each person, other than the permit holder, completing a P639 form to be listed and authorised by this permit.

#### What do I need to send with the application?

- A completed P638 'Application for a Prohibited Weapons Permit' form, and
- A completed 'Prohibited Weapon Production Genuine Reason' form, and
- A completed 'Business Declaration' (business application only), and
- Supporting documentation as requested on the genuine reason form.

#### What safe keeping level applies to this permit?

The information provided in the fact sheet is for general guidance only. Applicants

and licensees should familiarise themselves with the Firearms Act 1996 and the

associated Regulation, which are available on the NSW Legislation website -

Level 1 safe storage applies to prohibited weapons authorised by this permit. See the FACT Sheet 'Safe Storage Prohibited' Weapons Level 1, 2 & 3' & 'Prescribed Safe Storage for Schedule 1 Prohibited Weapons' for the storage level that applies to the weapons nominated for your permit.

You must meet or exceed the prescribed safe storage for the weapon concerned.

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#### What about employees?

A person who is an employee of the permit holder, or person who is engaged in the operation of the practice or organisation of the permit holder, may make application to be listed on and authorised by this permit. Each employee must complete an 'Application for a Person to be Authorised on a Prohibited Weapons Permit' P639 form. A separate P639 form must be used for each person wishing to be authorised by the permit.

All applicants must provide proof of identity totalling 100 points (if the person does not hold a current licence or permit). There is a prescribed fee of \$25 for each person in addition to the permit holder to be listed on the permit.

#### How do I apply for an Animal Management Permit?

You must complete the P638 'Application for a Prohibited Weapons Permit' form and the 'Prohibited Weapon Animal Management Genuine Reason' form and where applicable provide any supporting documentation. Please see below of this fact sheet for instructions on how to complete the P638 form.

### Instructions for completing the PW Permit Application Form

#### PROHIBITED WEAPONS PERMIT APPLICATION FORM (P638)

#### **NEW APPLICATION / REAPPLICATION**

Mark the appropriate box, new application or reapplication. If you currently hold, or have previously held, a firearms licence or firearms or prohibited weapon permit, enter your licence or permit number.

#### **SECTION A - PERMIT TYPE**

From the drop down list select the type of permit for which you are applying. If the permit is not listed in the drop down list, enter 'Other' and describe the type of permit you require in the space provided.

#### **SECTION B - NOMINATED PERSON / PERMIT HOLDER**

Insert the full name, date of birth, gender, NSW drivers licence (if held), contact phone numbers, email address and supply details for the nominated person (business) or nominated permit holder (individual). If you have been known by any other names enter your alias here.

#### **SECTION C - RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS**

Insert your full residential address in this section.

#### **SECTION D - POSTAL ADDRESS**

If the postal address is the same as the residential address, mark the box. If your postal address is different to your residential address, insert your postal address in this section.

#### SECTION E - BUSINESS, CLUB OR GOVERNMENT AGENCY DETAILS

If this application is being made by a Business, Club or Government Agency, complete this section and attach supporting documentation.

#### **SECTION F - SAFEKEEPING ADDRESS OF WEAPONS**

If the safekeeping address is the same as the residential address, select 'YES' in the box. If your weapon safekeeping address is different to your residential address, select 'NO' and insert the address in this section.

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#### **SECTION G - PERSONAL HISTORY**

Answer each question by selecting a 'YES' or 'NO' from the drop down list. If you answer 'YES' to any question, provide details as an attachment.

#### **SECTION H - DECLARATION**

The application must be signed and dated by the applicant.

#### **SECTION I - FEE**

The prescribed fee for a prohibited weapon permit is \$127. Your payment must accompany the application.
