6. OVERVIEW OF CURRENT CRIME TRENDS

OVERVIEW OF CURRENT CRIME TRENDS

Discussed by Crime Manager- Inspector Damien Goodfellow

- Assaults (Non DV) - increased for 8.4%
- Robberies - decreased for 55.8%
- Steal from person - decreased for 46.2%
- Break and Enter from Dwelling – decreased for 35.6%
- Steal from Dwelling – decreased for 22.00%
- Break and Enter (non Dwelling) – decreased for 26.4%
- Malicious Damage – decreased for 18.4%
- Stolen vehicles – decreased for 42.4%
- Steal from motor vehicles – decreased for 23.8%
- Steal from retail store – decreased for 8.6%
- NSW Police is encouraging people to report crime (Domestic and non-Domestic related crime).

7. Proactive Crime Team

Discussed by Detective Sergeant Gary Chetcuti

- Discussed the role of Proactive Crime Team (PCT)
- Good arrests by PCT, 2530 arrests – property crime related

- Reactive and monitoring – current historic low crime
- Crime hubs are: Hurstville and surrounding, Rockdale, Arncliffe and Wolli Creek
- Crime is opportunistic – not organised crime where 50 to 60% are drug users

8. Detectives

Discussed by Detective Senior Sergeant Brett Van-Akker

- Discussed the role of Detectives – there are 41 detectives including 6 Sergeants
- Type of jobs Detectives are involved in:
 - Aggravated Break and Enter
 - Sexual Assaults
 - Indecent Assaults
 - Child Offenders
 - Missing Persons
 - Serious Crime Investigations

9. NSW Police Transport Command – South/South West Sector

Discussed by Detective Chief Inspector Craig James

- Discussed the role of the Police Transport Command (PTC) – there are 610 Police Officers in Police Transport Command

In the period between March 2017 and April 2018 there were:

- 6531 Transport Offences detected
- 1680 Move on Directions issued
- 1004 Person Searches
- 113 Drug Detections
- 208 Arrests
- 336 Charges
- 308 Intelligence Reports created
