

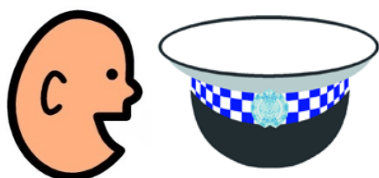


Making a complaint

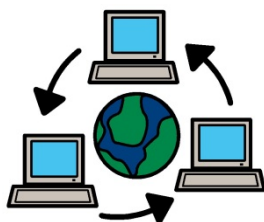
